

FAQs FOR THE PROGRAMME M.Sc. Nutrition and Dietetics

1. What is the admission process to apply for M.Sc. Nutrition and Dietetics programme?

Ans: Redirect to How to Apply on website

- Step 1: Online Registration on www.ssca.edu.in
- Step 2: Screening for Eligibility (Graduate in Life Sciences / Home Sciences / Health Sciences and any other Biological sciences from any recognized University/ Institution of National Importance with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade (45% marks or equivalent grade for Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes).
- Step 3: Personal Interaction with shortlisted candidates (No written exam) (Criteria for evaluation: Undergraduate academic score, general aptitude, subject knowledge, communication skills and extra-curricular achievement)
- Step 4: Declaration of merit list on www.ssca.edu.in

2. What is the Eligibility Criteria to apply for M.Sc. Nutrition and Dietetics programme?

Graduate in Life Sciences / Home Sciences / Health Sciences and any other Biological sciences from any recognized University/ Institution of National Importance with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade (45% marks or equivalent grade for Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes).
